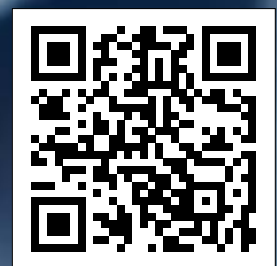

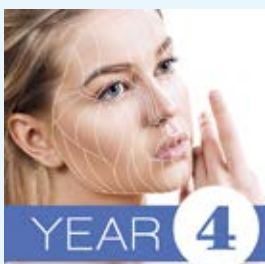

For two and a half days, the world's specialists in the sphere of facial plastic and aesthetic surgery will teach, debate and demonstrate their knowledge in **LIVE**.

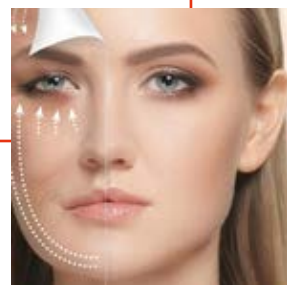
